3. The Cod Liver Oil Factory,
4. The Fishery,
5. School Days, or
6. The Church.

This project is open to ALL residents of Bauline and to ALL ages. We certainly hope to see a good show of interest in this very important aspect of our Town History.

As well, if you have items reflecting your history and heritage that you would like to donate, please feel free to bring them on that day. However, if you have items and are reluctant to donate them, we would like you to come share them with us on a display table of your own and at the end of the day take them back home with you.

Sexual assault is a crime that can affect anyone regardless of factors like age, gender, ability, social and cultural location, or other variables; and

The rate of sexual assault in Newfoundland and Labrador continues to be higher than the national average, and

This Municipal Government recognizes the need for people of our community to live in safe and caring communities where violence is unacceptable, and supports efforts that raise awareness and educate the public, and

Be it resolved that I, Craig LeGrow, Mayor of Bauline, do hereby proclaim September 17-21 September, 2018 as Sexual Violence Awareness Week and encourage all citizens to become involved in activities organized in Bauline and our neighboring communities throughout this week.
