The board can be a display of a brief history of your family, old and newer photos (appropriately labelled), stories, genealogy and any other family information you might like to share with everyone in order to help us all learn more about the families of our Town.

As well, if you would like to share information you may have on some historic aspect of Bauline please feel free to do so such as:

1. Traditions of years ago (Christmas, Easter, May 24th, Labor Day, etc.),
2. The Bark Pot at the top of the hill,
3. The Cod Liver Oil Factory,
4. The Fishery,
5. School Days, or
6. The Church.

This project is open to ALL residents of Bauline and to ALL ages. We certainly hope to see a good show of interest in this very important aspect of our Town History.

As well, if you have items reflecting your history and heritage that you would like to donate, please feel free to bring them on that day. However, if you have items and are reluctant to donate them, we would like you to come share them with us on a display table of your own and at the end of the day take them back home with you.
