Business Tax	\$425.00

- Taxes are due by 15 April 2018
- Payment by 31 March will receive 10% discount
- Residents in receipt of GIS may apply for 20% discount (*not to be combined with any other discount*)
- Interest will be 2% on taxes not received by due date.
