

## BULK GARBAGE

Bulk Garbage pick up will be from Monday October 16th. Please have everything curb side by Monday October 16th 9am especially any bulk items.

Friendly reminder during regular garbage collection please do not exceed more than 5 bags of garbage per household and not exceed 50 lb per bag.

- Ensure that all your bulk waste is out by the side of the road for pickup.
- Metals will have to be separated from bulk goods as they cannot be deposited in the landfill; (i.e. make one pile for metals and another pile for non-metal bulk garbage)
- Electronic waste such as computers and printers should also be separated;
- Hazardous material such as paint, oil, windshield wash etc. cannot be picked up; Residents are reminded that those items may be dropped off at Robin Hood Bay any Wednesday or Saturday;
- Bag or box any small items;
- Please box and tape any broken glass and clearly mark on the box “GLASS”, this is for the safety of the workers;
- Construction material will not be collected (no shingles, drywall, etc)
- Wooden furniture and household items will be collected.
- Loose items must not be over 4 feet long and should be bundled together;
- Bundled items should not be more than 50 lbs.;
- No fishing nets;
- No automotive parts, tires or batteries;
- No concrete;
- No trees, soil, branches or similar yard waste

## MAINTENANCE JOB POSITION

POSITION TITLE: Maintenance Worker /Part Time

DESIGNATED SUPERVISOR: Town Manager

Under the general supervision of the Town Manager or designated supervisor the Maintenance worker safely performs general duties for the operation and maintenance of the Town.

### MAJOR DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform a variety of manual work in support of the general upkeep, safety and maintenance of Town infrastructure and facilities.
- Conduct litter clean-up and assist with bulk garbage collection.
- Set up and dismantle for events including tents, barricades, signage, etc.
- Maintain open spaces and play areas for cleanliness and safety.
- Conduct snow removal with salting of steps and walkways and spotting.
- Perform traffic control including flagging duties.
- Ensure the safe use and upkeep of lawnmower, whipper snippers, snow blowers, hedge trimmer, brush cutter, grinders, concrete cutting tools, and power and hand tools.
- Set up signage, barricades, traffic control, chairs, tables, equipment, and materials in support of Town operations.
- Assist with road maintenance including asphalt repair, pothole filling and asphalt recycling.
- Assist in the maintenance and repair of walkways, catch basins, and water and sewer activities.
- Assist in the set up and maintenance of playground equipment.
- Perform painting duties and graffiti removal.
- Assist in building demolition and removal of sheds and cabins.

The above statement reflects the duties necessary to describe the principal functions of the job and shall not be considered as a detailed description of all the duties of the job.
