We will host a friends group bi-weekly starting the fall and continue throughout the winter, also have exercise activities or physical activity games such as cornhole, darts, horseshoes etc, lunch and learn sessions, craft and card game nights and senior outings which may include visiting historic sites, berry picking, boil ups, and chances to socialize with seniors outside our community.
